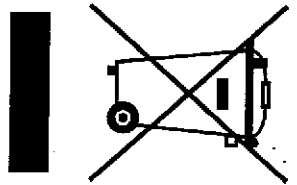
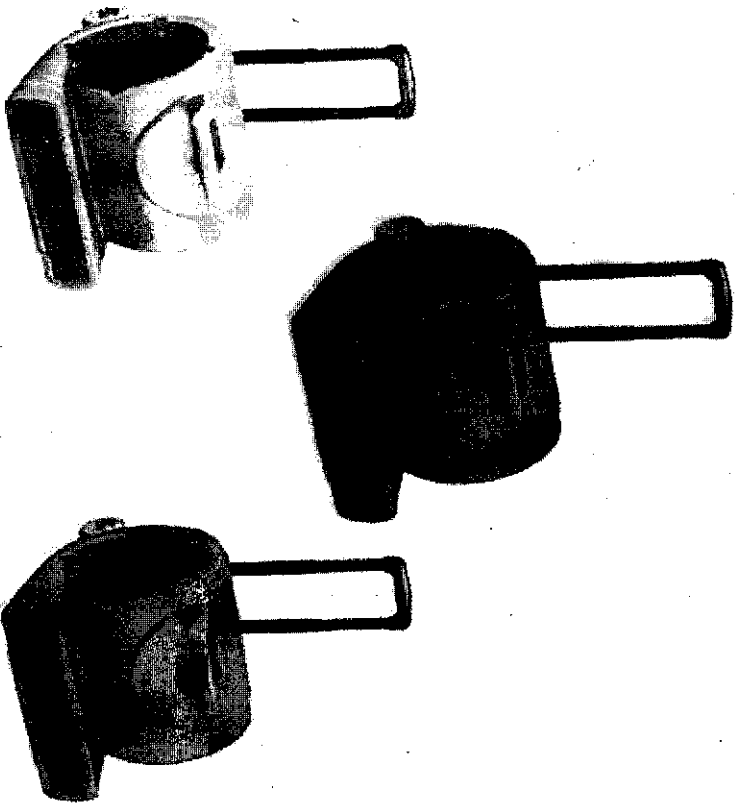

# Chapter I General Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the HW-900 This Product is easy and safe to use. It is ideal for drying and ventilation after the cleaning of carpet and other floor surfaces. It is particularly suitable for hotels, offices, halls and other large public spaces.

## Chapter II Cautions

- VI. Assure the voltage and frequency of the power supply is the same as the device.

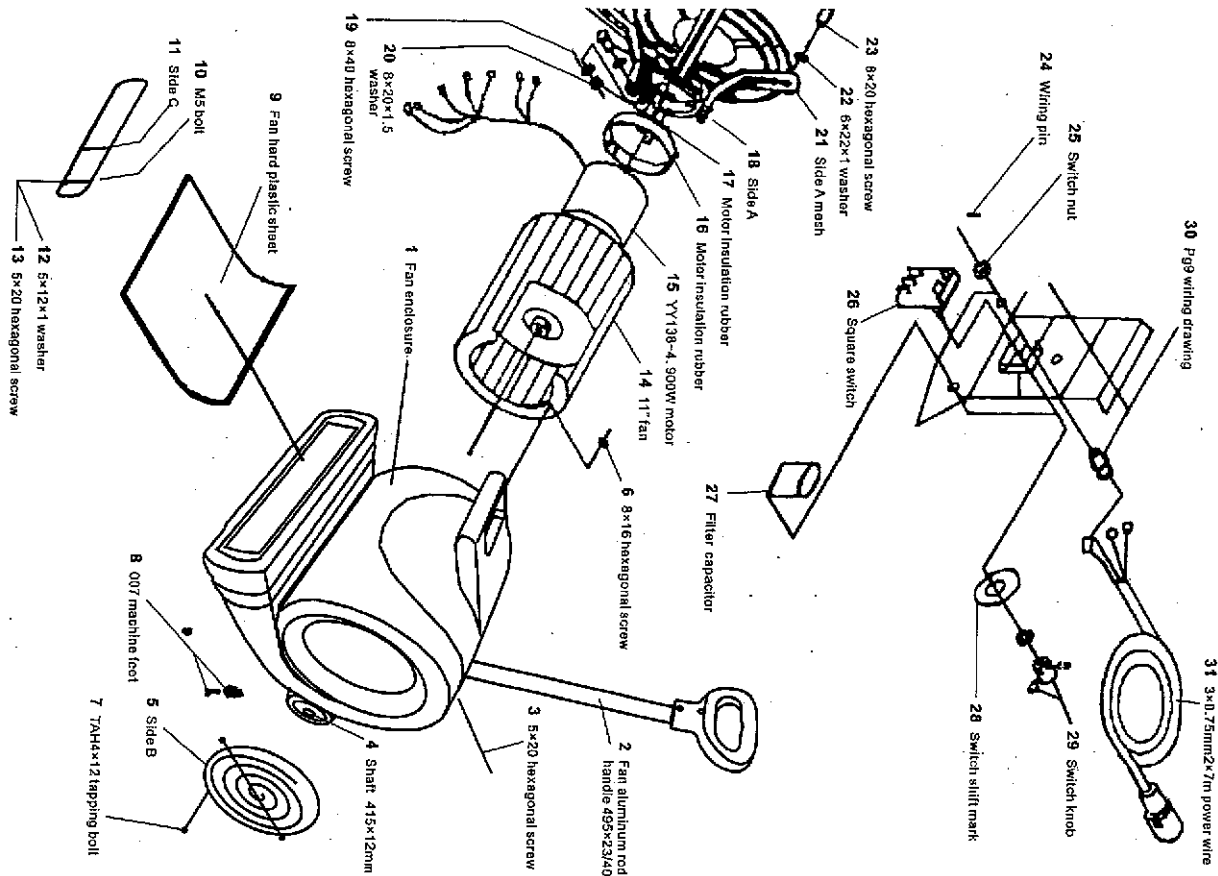
# Chapter III Main Technical Parameters

Faults	Possible Reasons	Solutions
Motor doesn't work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>① Power wire is not connected correctly;</li> <li>② Power switch is loose;</li> <li>③ Motor is damaged.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>① Check power wire;</li> <li>②③ Ask the manufacturer or professional technician to repair.</li> </ul>
Motor starts slowly	12. 5UF capacitor is damaged	Replace the capacitor
Motor makes abnormal sound	Fan is damaged during transportation, fan enclosure is distorted	Replace the fan or fan enclosure
