



## ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT POLICY

### POLICY

*The management of Master Hire aims to provide a sustainable working environment where all activities carried out on its premises or undertaken by its team members are conducted in such a way that no or minimal harm is created to the environment.*

#### Management will

- Determine key environmental objectives including standards for all areas of operation to ensure relevant legislative requirements and societal expectations are met or exceeded

- Proactively choose environmentally sustainable practices (e.g. natural lighting and rain or recycled water) and products where practicable
- Proactively choose environmentally sustainable products (e.g. environmentally safe chemicals, solar powered and/or low emission equipment) where practicable
- Regularly consult with, and include team members on means to continually improve environmental outcomes
- Provide environmental training and education to all Team Members

#### Employees will

- Support management to eliminate or minimise the impact of operations to the environment through participation, contribution, cooperation and involvement
- Minimise waste through efficient use of all products, materials and chemicals
- Only dispose of waste through approved processes, procedures and approved facilities
- Ensure all health and safety measures are adopted at all times
- Report any situations or practices that are contrary to this policy
